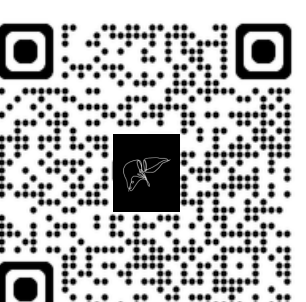
- These interactions will be held across 6 monthly sessions, online and in-person.
